

Construction Site Security Plan

Site Access

- All volunteers and church members will be required to review and sign the volunteer release form.
- Only those 18 years and older are permitted to be in the construction zone during construction activities. Younger volunteers may participate on a clean-up crew after construction has stopped for the day.

Storage

- Equipment, tools, and smaller size construction materials will be stored in the garage or in one of two 53 foot semi-trailers that will be left on property until the completion of the construction project. The Tool Manager and/or crew leader will ensure that the equipment is properly secured in the trailers at the conclusion of each day.
- Once the building is able to be locked, it can also be used to store materials and construction equipment.

Lighting

- Motion lights will be installed at the beginning of the construction to deter any unwanted visitors.
- Outside flood lights will be left on at night.

Watchman

- Someone will be on site 24/7 during the time materials arrive on site the first of May until the last of the materials stored on the ground are used and the new building can be locked. This is expected to be mid-August. The watchman will make walking rounds through the site and will be awake at all times. If unusual activity is observed, the watchman will call the police. Watchmen will not confront unauthorized visitors.
- The Grand Chute Police Department will also be contacted and asked to make additional drive-bys to deter any illegal activity.
- The Grand Chute Police Department should be contacted immediately upon discovering that a theft and/or vandalism have occurred.
