

Checklists

Pre-arrival

- You have your protective equipment; work gloves, sturdy shoes (steel toe recommended), safety glasses, and a hard hat, if you have one.
- You have signed and returned the volunteer waiver form
- You have read the safety and security manuals
- You know what 3 three-second blasts of the air horn mean; immediately go to the storm shelter
- You have notified the volunteer coordinator what days you will be on site
- You put your name on any tools you will bring

First Day

- You attend the safety briefing
- You find the AED and the yellow emergency placards
- You find one or more routes to the emergency storm shelter

Every Day

- You eat a hearty breakfast
- You follow the safety rules and never take chances, even for a minute
- You drink a lot of water all day
- Send a list of answered prayers to the Prayer Team
- You keep your work area clean and unobstructed

Last Day

- You have collected your tools and protective equipment
- You have cleaned up your work area.
