Cautions and instructions concerning the land God is giving them.

- Remember to always turn to God 9:13-10:1-11
 - Understand the gravity of disobedience against God.
 - Note the example of Moses turning to God as the source of hope and help in the midst of the rebellion of His people.
 - Note the mercy of God extended to His people in response to Moses' intercession.
 - Note God's longsuffering toward his people in the reissuing of the Commandments.
 - Reminder that God has provided the Levites as a "buffer" between Him and the people so that they would not be consumed. (See Numbers 8:19)

 - Serve Him with all your heart and soul
 - Keep the commandments and statutes

 - Because of Who God is.
 - Absolute ruler of the heaven and earth
 - Great, mighty and awesome
 - Righteous
 - Just
 - Merciful

 - Because of what God has done
 - Set His heart in love on the Patriarchs
 - Chosen their offspring as His people
 - His acts in bringing them out of Egypt, through the wilderness and to this place
 - Multiplied the people greatly
