Cautions and instructions concerning the land God is giving them.

- A renewed covenant with a new generation 29:1-30:20
  - Everyone present, except Moses, Joshua and Caleb, would have been under the age of 60 since everyone over 20 years old at the time of the refusal to enter the Promised Land 40 years earlier had died in the wilderness according to God's judgment on their disobedience. (Numbers 14:26-38)

Cautions and instructions concerning the land God is giving them.

- A renewed covenant with a new generation 29:1-30:20
  - God's faithfulness recounted 29:1-9
    - Appeal to the eyewitnesses of the power of God unleashed on the Egyptians to deliver the Israelites.
      - Verse 4 indicates that although God had provided these and many other signs and wonders, the rebellious actions of the people reveal that they had not taken them to heart.

  - God's faithfulness recounted 29:1-9
    - Appeal to the experience of God's provision in the wilderness
      - Clothing and sandals had endured for 40 years.
      - Fed with manna from heaven
      - Victory over opposition
  - Appeal for obedience in the face of God's faithfulness

Cautions and instructions concerning the land God is giving them.

- A renewed covenant with a new generation 29:1-30:20
  - A covenant with all who are present and with future generations. 29:10-15
    - Note that it includes even those who are not ethnic Israelites. The indication is that everyone in Moses' hearing is required to live under the commandments and statutes given and would be subject to both the blessings of obedience and the curses of disobedience.

Cautions and instructions concerning the land God is giving them.

- A renewed covenant with a new generation 29:1-30:20
  - A warning of the poisonous influence and consequence of one who rebels against the commands of God. 29:16-28
    - Note that this is in the context of idolatry.
    - This person will not individually escape and the "bitter fruit" they produce will bring judgment on the whole nation.
    - The nations surrounding Israel will be appalled at the judgment on the land and the explanation will be that the people rejected God's covenant through their idolatrous rebellion.

    - God has not told His people everything there is to know but has told them all they need to know.

    - In response to the people turning back to Him in all the places they have been scattered, God will have mercy on them and:
      - Restore them to the land He has given them.
      - Make them more numerous and prosperous than before
      - God will give them the ability to love Him wholeheartedly. (See Deuteronomy 10:16, Ezekiel 11:14-20; 36:24-32, Romans 2:29)
