When we got up high, I couldn't resist taking a look around, that was kind of the point! The view was incredible! It is amazing what you can see the higher you get off the ground!! You can see so much farther and your perspective of things is just different. I was immediately struck by the fact that even though I could see all the way to Kaukauna, it wasn't close to the scope of the view God has of His earth.

Psalm 33:13-15 describes it this way: *"The LORD looks down from heaven; He sees all the children of man; from where He sits enthroned, He looks out on all the inhabitants of the earth, He who fashions the hearts of them all and observes all their deeds"*.

Sometimes, when we are in the midst of a great difficulty, when it feels like the present trial is just hitting us in the face, we may need a different perspective, the perspective of God. The Lord sees it all and He cares for it all! He can look further down the road than we can, He sees how this will shape us. We have to trust that the Lord will use whatever circumstance we are in to make us more Christ like. The word "look" in the above verse means: to look intently at; by implication, to regard with pleasure, favor or care.

The Lord doesn't look at us with just a passing glance, He is looking intently because He cares about every aspect of our lives. And that means He sees you not only when you are rejoicing but also when you are struggling with something. His view is perfect and unobstructed!! Nothing is blocking His gaze! He sees it all. He sees you. He watches you from the very throne of heaven. It is a reason to praise Him!!

And while watching from heaven, He is also right in our midst...He is not distant! And no matter what you are facing today, He is your Savior, your Helper, your Peace! And if you feel like your feet are stuck in the muck and mire of this thing called life, adjust your view. Lift up your eyes to the Maker of heaven and earth (Psalm 121). Look toward the throne until Jesus is in full focus and is your focus.
