The phone rang. Shad Rue, then the pastor of Paramount Baptist Church in Amarillo, Texas was calling. I had met Pastor Shad a couple of months before. He was calling to invite me to join their next mission trip to Brazil. He told me that someone had committed to pay for the trip and all I needed to do was agree to go. I chose to seize what I thought was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. That opportunity blossomed to ministry in three different Brazilian states, over 30 trips, and along with Stan Hanes, founding Amazon Basin Ministries that facilitates mission trips on the Upper Amazon.

Another phone call. This one was to inform me of a church looking for a new senior pastor. That same clear prompting I knew years before with the invitation for ministry in Brazil was there. The rest, as they say, is history as I completed my 23rd year here as senior pastor of Valley Baptist Church the first Sunday of November.

For the follower of our Lord Jesus Christ events like this are more than opportunities. They are God's invitation to join Him in His work. These are opportunities in the sense that we can choose to engage or let the opportunity pass. Even after we seize the opportunity, we then must continue to faithfully fulfill all God reveals to us as His plan unfolds.

The Bible is littered with people who squandered opportunities. Adam and Eve, King Saul, the Israelites when they initially approached the Promised Land, Judas, the Jews who rejected Jesus, all had the opportunity to experience all God had for them and reach the potential for which God created them. Yet, the opportunity was crushed under the weight of self-centeredness.

The Bible also gives great examples of those who faithfully engaged in the opportunities God laid before them. These include Abraham, Joseph, Ruth, Esther, the Old Testament prophets, the Apostles, and yes, the ultimate

example, our Lord Jesus Christ. Through every challenge and hardship these faithfully, and in the case of Jesus, perfectly embraced the opportunities God the Father set before them.

Joining God in what He reveals to you may lead to huge life-altering decisions and put you on a path you never imagined. These opportunities may also come as a simple adjustment of your schedule during the day to join God in what He is doing. Whether large or small, God will place these opportunities before you. Faithfully engaging in these opportunities will have the result of preparing people to meet Jesus.
