

#### **Honest Questions**

Years ago, I heard a teaching by Jill Briscoe. She mentioned that as she and her husband Stewart Briscoe had traveled around the world engaging people with the truths of the gospel, they had discovered that there are three questions on the minds of people across the diverse groups of people they encountered. "Is God there?" "Is God aware?" "Does God care?"

I would imagine as you read this you realize that there have been times in your life when these were honest and sincere questions. It is not wrong to ask questions. That is one of the best ways we can learn. Never be ashamed of the questions that come into your mind. As long as you are sincerely looking for an answer, questions are often a key to live-giving answers.

It is important that you go to the right place for the answers. The Bible beautifully and wonderfully answers the questions observed by the Briscoes. You don't have to get past the first verse of the Bible to find the definitive answer to the first question. God's existence is so certain it is simply stated as a matter of fact that "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." (Genesis 1:1, ESV)

The Bible is a record of God's involvement in the world that He created. His interactions with people throughout history punctuates that fact, that He is aware of the smallest detail of every life. This is the word of God to the prophet Jeremiah, ""Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations."" (Jeremiah 1:5, ESV) Jesus astounded Nathanael when He revealed that He was aware of Nathanael spending some quiet time in prayer under his fig tree. (John 1:45-51) Jesus revealed the awareness of God over the details of this world in these words, "Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? And not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father." (Matthew 10:29, ESV)

The coming of our Lord Jesus Christ into the world to teach us about God the Father and then to die on the cross is the answer to God's care. God has provided for the greatest need we have. That is the need for our sin to be forgiven so we may have fellowship with Him both now and in eternity. The ministry of our Lord Jesus Christ touched real people at their point of need. He encouraged the little children to come to Him. People in the throes of oppression and sin were drawn to him and found compassionate forgiveness and lasting transformation.

Preparing people to meet Jesus is all about helping people find the biblical answers to the questions, "Is God there?" "Is He aware?" "Does He care?" Don't be afraid to ask those questions. Embrace them when others ask and direct them toward the live-giving answers in God's Holy Word.


