- "The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham." (Matthew 1:1, ESV)
- "And as Jesus passed on from there, two blind men followed him, crying aloud, "Have mercy on us, Son of David."" (Matthew 9:27, ESV)
- "And all the people were amazed, and said, "Can this be the Son of David?"" (Matthew 12:23, ESV)

- "But when the chief priests and the scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying out in the temple, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" they were indignant," (Matthew 21:15, ESV)
- "saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose son is he?" They said to him, "The son of David."" (Matthew 22:42, ESV)
- **5** Jesus the Messiah is the son of David.
 - "Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, the offspring of David, as preached in my gospel," (2 Timothy 2:8, ESV)

6 Jesus the Messiah is not just the son of David.

- The Messiah has authority greater than any earthly king.
 - "But he said to them, "How can they say that the Christ is David's son? For David himself says in the Book of Psalms, " 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool." ' David thus calls him Lord, so how is he his son?"" (Luke 20:41–44, ESV)

7 🔲 Jesus the Messiah is not just the son of David.
