- He summoned all the people who purported to have special insight and wisdom.
 - Their sources of wisdom are reflected in the different terminology to describe them.
 - Some used astronomy and astrology
 - Some used special incantations or spells

 - Some used the entrails of animals
 - Some studied writings
 - Sacrifices were offered to their idols to try to gain insights

 - Nebuchadnezzar wanted to make sure the interpretation was accurate.
 - He wanted to be sure these men did not give him an opinion or guess.
 - He offered a great reward for compliance.

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream

- Nebuchadnezzar made the astounding request that these men tell what he had dreamed and then give the interpretation.
 - He assured destruction and death if they did not or could not do all he asked.
 - All of these men replied that this was an unreasonable request and could only be supernaturally granted.

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream

- Nebuchadnezzar ordered the execution of all the wise men of Babylon.
 - Since Daniel, Hananiah, Azariah, and Mishael were in this group they would suffer the same fate.
 - Again, God's favor rested on Daniel to the extent that Arioch, the captain of the guard, explained the situation to Daniel.
 - Daniel then went in and requested that the king give him a time to present the interpretation.

- Nebuchadnezzar ordered the execution of all the wise men of Babylon.
 - Daniel then went to his companions and urged them to pray that God would grant them mercy by revealing the dream.
 - God did reveal the dream to Daniel that night.

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream

- Nebuchadnezzar ordered the execution of all the wise men of Babylon.
 - Daniel responded first by heartfelt praise and thanksgiving to God.
 - Daniel's standing is revealed by the fact that Arioch went to the king with the confident assertion that he had found one who would make the interpretation known.

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream

- Daniel both revealed and interpreted the dream.
 - At Nebuchadnezzar's inquiry if he could disclose the dream and interpretation, Daniel agreed with the other wise men that no man could accomplish this but revealed that there is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries.

 - The Interpretation
 - The statue represents the present kingdom and ensuing kingdoms of the world.
 - Head of gold-Babylon under Nebuchadnezzar
 - Chest and arms of silver- Medo-Persian Empire
 - Middle and thighs of bronze-Greek Empire
 - Legs of iron-Roman Empire
 - Feet mixture of iron and clay-Various nations of the world after the Roman Empire

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream

- Daniel both revealed and interpreted the dream.
 - The Interpretation
 - A stone struck the image at the feet completely destroying the whole image.
 - The stone became a great mountain and filled the earth-God's kingdom.
 - Daniel ended by again showing that a great God had revealed these things to him.

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream

- Nebuchadnezzar's response
 - Honored Daniel probably to the point of embarrassment
 - Declared that Daniel's God is the God above all gods and the Lord above all king.
 - Rewarded Daniel richly both materially and in elevated position
 - Made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon
 - Daniel requested that his three companions take this position
 - Made him chief over all the wise men of Babylon
