- Chapter 12 jumps to events that are future to our time.
- Reminder that God has assigned His most powerful warrior angel as Israel's defender.

God's final revelations to Daniel 10:1-12:13

- The Israelites will go through all the judgments of God including the wrath of God in the Bowl judgments after the church is taken out of the world.
- The preservation of the children of Israel is again confirmed and assured.
- The fact that a name is written in a book is the important factor here.
- This is the only time resurrection is clearly mentioned in the Old Testament.

God's final revelations to Daniel 10:1-12:13

- The conversation between the angelic beings and Daniel
 - First, looks to the very end times as connected with Daniel 7:25 and Revelation 12:14. Time, times, half a time indicates that the time for these events has been established by God.
 - Then the conversation turns back to the events of chapters 8 and 11 which speak of the suffering and the deliverance of the Israelites over the next few hundred years culminating with the persecution and restoration during the reign of Antiochus Epiphanes.
