

# **Freedom to Live**

Easter was way back in March of this year. In our 24-hour news cycle that seems like an eternity. Yet the event of the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ was not a story that would soon die. The focus of that story was and is alive.

Jesus punctuated the fact of His resurrection by multiple post resurrection appearances over the next 40 days. Those who follow our Lord Jesus Christ do not simply buy into a certain philosophy of life. We live under the lordship of a risen Savior and Lord. We obey the instructions He gave us. His priorities determine our priorities.

The beauty of the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ is that we have the opportunity to live in the power of that resurrection. Our passionate cry should echo that of the Apostle Paul when he exclaimed, "that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection". The New Testament book of Romans, Chapter 6, details the freedom we have by our identification in the death, burial, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. The power of sin has been broken and now we have the freedom to fully engage in the new life we have been given in Christ. This truth is driven home by these words, "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." (Galatians 2:20, ESV)

We are no longer slaves to sin. What a liberating message! Preparing people to meet Jesus means that we can help those around us understand that freedom has been secured and is available to all who will come to our Lord Jesus Christ for salvation. What follows is the potential of a life free to live under the lordship of Jesus Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit to the glory of God the Father.




