2 The reality of the body of Jesus placed and secured in the tomb was an indisputable fact.

3 The women disciples of Jesus were the first eyewitnesses of the empty tomb.

- They observed the perplexing reality that the tomb was empty.
- They were eyewitnesses to the angelic proclamation that Jesus had risen from the dead.
- They gave witness of their eyewitness account to the eleven disciples.

- 4 The witness of the eleven remaining male disciples of Jesus.
 - They responded to the eyewitness account with skepticism and unbelief.
 - Peter (and John) ran to the tomb and also became eyewitnesses to the fact that the tomb was empty.
