2 Living in a broken world calls for careful discernment.

• "Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil." (Ephesians 5:15–16, ESV)

3 Knowing and doing the will of God rescues us from the foolishness of our ways.

4 A life controlled by the Holy Spirit is the key to choosing to live wisely.

5 Choosing wisely will be marked by adoration to God and encouragement to other followers of Christ.

• "addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart," (Ephesians 5:19, ESV)

- 6 Choosing wisely will be marked by thanksgiving as contrasted to a sense of entitlement.
  "giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ," (Ephesians 5:20, ESV)
- 7 Choosing wisely will be marked by the recognition and celebration of the presence of the Spirit of God in other followers of Christ.
  - "submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ." (Ephesians 5:21, ESV)
