Connected. Are you connected? What comes to mind when you hear that word? Webster's defines it as being "joined or linked together." Many of us immediately think of relationships we have with family members, coworkers, or neighbors. Some may even think of connections they have through social media. It's a beautiful thing to live out that relational part of God's design for every human being. But as women who know God personally through Jesus Christ, we're connected in a special way through the Holy Spirit. What an amazing gift that is! We're so excited about this that we've changed our women's ministry name to *Connected*. But it's not just a name change with updated graphics. *"Side by side, together for the Gospel"* is the expression of a deepening focus and conviction the Lord has been forming in our hearts, and we want to share it with you as we begin a new ministry year. Paul expresses this in many of his letters. In Philippians, his love for those believers comes out in his references to them as *partners* and working *side by side* for the Gospel. (Phil 1:5,7,27; 4:3) In Ephesians, we see that believers are being built *together* into a dwelling place of God as we *together* build up the body of Christ in love. (Eph 2:21-22; 4:16) There are also many references to *one another* in scripture: "*Comfort one another, confess your sins to one another, love one another, pray for one another, instruct one another, build up one another, be kind to one another, carry one another's burdens.*" Wow. What a picture of being truly connected through Jesus Christ! This experience of sharing our own lives with each other and serving side by side as we share and live out the Gospel, is beautiful. We want more of it ourselves, and we believe you do too.

We desire to be used by God to create opportunities for women to build these relationships with one another, growing deeper in love for Him and for each other as we do so. What drives us to do this? As members of the body of Christ at Valley Baptist church, you are dear to us! We echo Paul's statement to those in Thessalonica: "*We cared so much for you that we were pleased to share with you not only the Gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become dear to us.*" (1 Th 2:8 CSB)

Will you join us? Together, let's pray for opportunities to grow in this area of our lives. Let's look for practical ways to live out those *one another's* in order to shine as lights in this world and advance the Gospel. Let's take advantage of opportunities to connect with other sisters in Christ and experience the joy of community centered on the love of Jesus. Let's take the time to *stay connected, living side by side, together for the Gospel*.
