Men gather at VBC the first Saturday of each month for a breakfast, fellowship, worship, and a teaching directed at men.

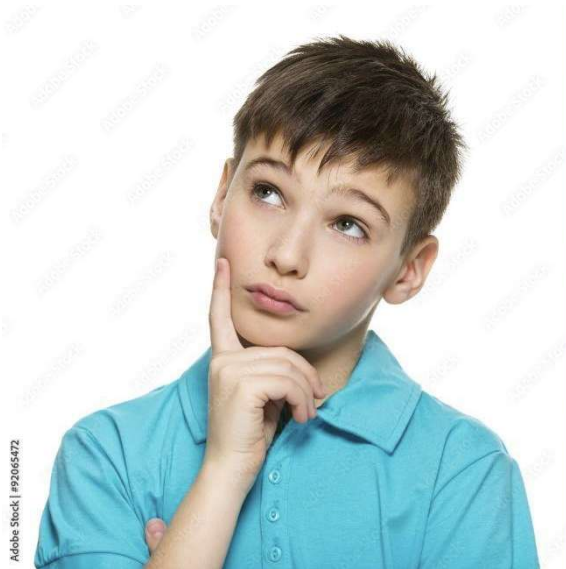
